Eligibility: Texas school districts and open-enrollment charter schools in which 45% or more of students in the district have been identified as economically disadvantaged for each of the three preceding school years (2007-2008, 2006-2007, and 2005-2006).

Purpose:

Support independent school districts and/or open-enrollment charter schools in implementing a supplemental technology-based instructional pilot program in the foundation curriculum areas of English language arts, mathematics, science, and/or social studies for students in grades 9-12 identified as being at risk of dropping out of school, as described by Texas Education Code (TEC) Section 29.081(d). TEA will award selected school districts state grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$50 per student, with a match required of at least \$50 per student from federal, state, or local funds, including private donations.
