- Entrepreneurship I is a level 2 course in animal science, plant science, carpentry, electrical, HVAC and sheet metal, masonry, plumbing and pipefitting, printing and imaging, cosmetology and personal care, welding, culinary arts, automotive and collision repair, and diesel and heavy equipment maintenance and commercial drivers.
- Anatomy and Physiology is a level 3 course in fire science.
- Business Law is a level 2 course in legal studies.
- Forensic Science is a level 4 course in law enforcement and legal studies.
- Touch System Data Entry and Business English are also available in the statewide course catalog.
